
A New Peak Number of the Employees

By the end of 2005, the number of employees reached 41,270, an increase of 8,477 from the end of 2004. The optoelectronics industry was the largest employer with 27,880, followed by the IC industry with 8,745. About 35.4% of the STSP employees have bachelor degrees and up; 56% have household registries in Tainan County, Tainan City and Kaohsiung County demonstrating the employment opportunities generated by the STSP. In addition, due to the consideration of the great demand of STSP enterprises for labor force, 723 foreign laborers have been introduced since 2005.

Growing Leasing Out Rate of Land and Standard Factories

By the end of 2005, 88% and 93% (including pre-lease contracts) of Phase I and 55% and 77% (including pre-lease contracts) of Phase II Sites of the Tainan Science Park were leased out, respectively, while the Kaohsiung Science Park leased out 60% and 77% (including pre-lease contracts). By the end of 2005, 105 out of 183 units of standard factories were leased for a 57% leasing rate.
