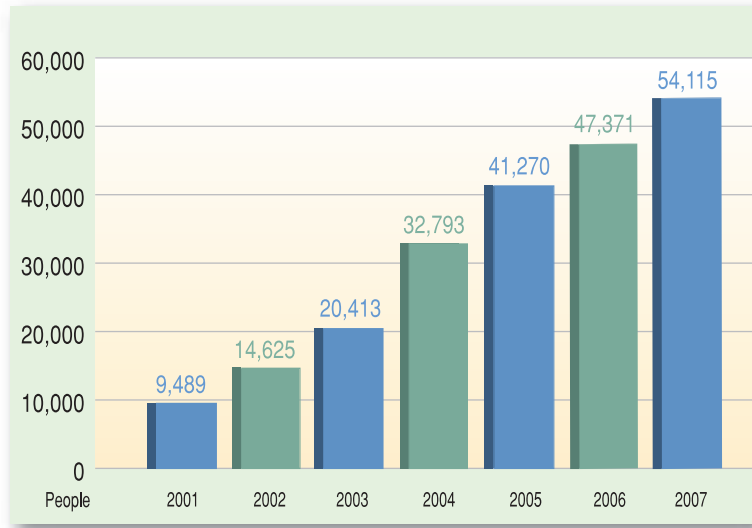
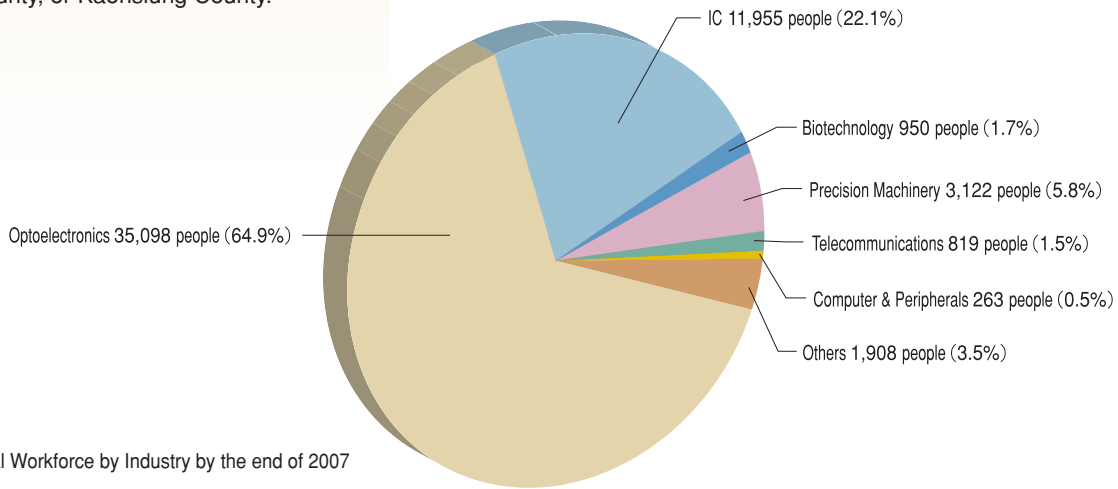


Total Workforce Exceeds 54,000

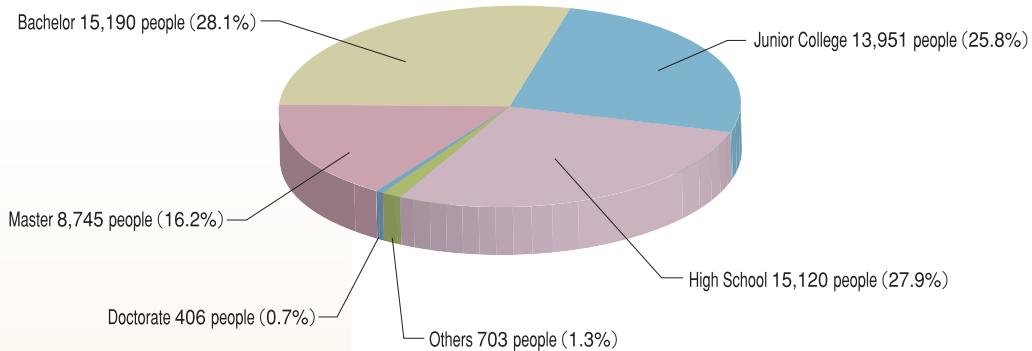
A total 54,115 people were employed by the STSP at the end of 2007, an increase of 6,774 people on 2006. The optoelectronics industry employed 35,098 people, or 64.9% of the total workforce by far the biggest employer in the Park; the second largest being the IC industry, which employed 11,955 people, or 22.1% of the total workforce. A total 70.8% of all employees hold degrees from a junior college or more advanced educational institution. As a testament to the amount of local employment opportunities created by the STSP, 73.6% of those employed are residents of Tainan City, Tainan County, or Kaohsiung County.

Steady Growth in Land Leasing

At the end of 2007, the land occupancy rate for the TSP Phase-I Site was 90.6%, or 95.5% including assigned areas; the land occupancy rate for the TSP Phase-II Site was 56.3%, or 57.1% including assigned areas; the land occupancy rate for the KSP was 44.2%, or 68.5% including assigned areas.
