Life Hub Opened

The Life Hub in TSP opened on September 13, 2007 making life in the dormitory complexes even more convenient. This is the first daily-life oriented facility in a science park that has successfully commissioned internal operations to the private sector according to the "Statute for Promoting Private Participation in Public Construction." These operations include the third-floor service center, second-floor sky bridge linking the two buildings, and a 125-space parking lot on floors B1 and B2. The

Hub currently holds a daycare service, an after school program for students, a variety of shops, an audio-visual room, a club room, an aerobics studio, and a central plaza.
