

Message from the Director-general

2009 : We overcame the impact of the financial crisis with the help of the Park enterprises and determination and accumulated energy for the next wave of industrial growth.

2009 : We approved the investment of 18 Park enterprises.

2009 : We promoted Subsidies for Encouraging Innovation and R&D, Professional and Technical Talent Training as well as Strengthening and Improving Program. The Strengthening and Improving Program provided a total of NT\$120 million in subsidies and retained 500 core R&D personnel to strengthen R&D and innovation capabilities.

2009 : We Promoted Southern Taiwan Biomedical Device Industry Cluster Development Plan introducing ten medical device manufacturers and two R&D institutes to the Park with the investment capital exceeding NT\$800 million.

2009 : To incorporate the "Rising Green Energy Industry Plan" of the Executive Yuan, we has worked with the Metal Industries Research & Development Center and the High Concentration Photovoltaic (HCPV) Qualification and Development Center of the Institute of Nuclear Energy Research at Kaohsiung Science Park to construct an integrated green industry cluster with complete supply chain.

2010 : We established three development directions in regards to sustainability, industrial cluster development, and promotion of cultural art to develop a Green Science Park model with unique features that will boost Taiwan's international competitiveness and contribute to global environmental sustainability.
