

Public Art

Beauty of Craft, Fusion of Human Culture

To provide a unique and artistic sensation for Park employees and visitors to the STSP, the STSP Administration, beginning in 2009, installed more than 20 pieces of public art work in five major areas at the Tainan Science Park (the Plaza in front of the STSP Administration Building, dormitory area, open space area, detention ponds, and major intersections and corners). The most appropriate artwork of different artists has been selected according to the features of different areas.

The Plaza in front of the STSP Administration Building

The work of art entitled "Rings" presents the continuous growth of life. Every five years, two lines will be extended toward the Plaza's direction in front of the STSP Administration as a symbol of sustainability.

Dormitory Area

The sculpture and street furniture here create a warm atmosphere symbolizing "people gathering" and "home."

Open Space Area

The interactive artistic playground equipment and street furniture here make the best use of spatial features to present public art and create an interaction between parents and children. The surrounding street layout inspires people to take a walk here.

Detention Ponds

The waterfront and leisure function interactive artistic installation is designed to bring people close to the water area and build a more user-friendly Park space.

Major Intersections and Corners

Objective artwork punctuates the Park entrances and the "Water Tank at East Entrance," the landmark installation of the STSP, is the representative public artwork of the three Science Parks in Taiwan.

Greeting Ribbon for the Prosperous STSP

The steel structured "Greeting Ribbon" at the South Entrance of Tainan Science Park was completed on January 25, 2010. This ribbon symbolizes a greeting from the STSP to all of its visitors as well as welcomes the contribution of Taiwanese businessmen and youth. It provides a sensational appeal of returning home and contribution to their hometown. The entrance was constructed by the lake in the shape of a flying ribbon to balance the dynamic speed and centrifugal force experienced when travelling to the South Entrance of the Park. With the reflection of lake surface, the sign on the flying ribbon states the "Rise of the South," and signifies its prosperity and hope.
