2010 International Exhibition on Korean Advanced Industry and the Joint Meeting of Taiwan and Korean Enterprises

The STSP Administration, on April 16, co-hosted the "International Exhibition of Korean Advanced Industry and the Joint Meeting of Taiwan and Korean Enterprises" with the Asian Science Park Association (ASPA), SME Incubator at Tainan Science Park, Small and Medium Enterprise Administration, and Southern Taiwan Innovation and Research Park to successfully promote business opportunities between Taiwan and Korea. It was highly praised by participating enterprises.

Led by the Director of General Practical Affairs and Business of ASPA Secretariat, Mr. Nam Young-Ho, 18 enterprise representatives from Korean machinery, metal, and electric and electronics clusters in Gumi, Seongseo, Chungbuk, and Changwon participated in product launch and business meetings with dozens of Taiwanese enterprises at the SME Incubator at Tainan Science Park. Through face to face contacts and negotiations, business cooperation has been facilitated. The meeting enabled practical achievements and was expected to successfully initiate cooperative projects for 18 products for the amount of approximately US\$3.9 million.

Participation in the 2010 IASP Annual Meeting and Presentation on Green Science Parks

On August 31, the STSP Administration signed a MOU with the Daejeon Science and Technology Park, Korea with the aim of establishing a platform for bilateral cooperation and exchange and to improve the international visibility of the STSP. Participation in the 2010 Annual Meeting of the ASPA

The STSP Administration participated in the 2010 Annual Meeting of ASPA held in Australia between November 24 and 26, and entered two papers respectively entitled "Innovative Platform that Attracts and Promotes Investment - A Case Study on the Biomedical Device Industrial Cluster at Kaohsiung Science Park" and "Policy Formation Procedure of the Biomedical Device Designated Area at Kaohsiung Science Park" that were co-presented with the MIRDC and NCKU. In addition, GenMont was recommended to represent Taiwan in order to participate in the ASPA Awards and was presented with the Excellence Prize.
