New Source of Water Supply for Reliable Water Use

The third water supply pond in the KSP was completed on July 1 equipped with the main facility of 55,000 tons of underground water supply and water pumping machinery room (including an Electrical Control Room and an Emergency Generator Room). The shape of machinery room of water supply pond was designed in the child-like style with mass accumulation. The building was presented under the nature and simple principle to integrate with landscape. This commenced water supply pond not only shoulders the big responsibility to provide stable water supply to Park enterprises but also symbolizes a more comprehensive network built for industrial water use in the KSP.

To allow large construction trucks to enter the site of emergency repair of underground sewage pipeline of Phase II sewage plant in the TSP, we removed dozens of trees. After the emergency repair was completed, the STSPB prepared 34 seedlings of Flamegold-rain trees. Led by former Deputy Director-general, Lin Yeongshown, trees were planted symbolizing the new life in the STSP.

In the beginning of 2015, the STSPB firstly built the bike lane on the pedestrian bridge of Dazhou Drainage in the TSP and completed the creative installation art of Hydreigon image. Then in the end of the same year, at the two sides of the bridge entrance, dinosaur shaped traffic barriers were installed. When pedestrians walk on the bridge, they will feel like being in Jurassic Park and just let their imagination fly.

Building Secret Garden in KSP

A total of 2,118 trees and 5,428 seedlings of Autumn Maple Tree and Golden Show Tree in alternative planting were planted to develop pedestrian tree landscape. Beautiful evergreen common garcinia trees were planted along with the border of the Park. Additionally, the STSPB planted diverse native ecological seedlings to build the habitat paradise for birds, insects, and small animals. At the same time, a gravel trail was paved for a stress relief walk full of phytoncid in the secret garden.
