# **Future Prospects**

It has been 9 years since STSP was established. Based on the brilliant achievements in development and operation in the past 8 years, the Administration will attempt to meet the following future objectives in 2005 in order to promote industrial and overall development in southern Taiwan.

# Prospect 1 Reach enterprises recruitment and business goals.

Our goals are to attract at least 20 tenant enterprises to the STSP in 2005 (two of which are international companies) and boost the population of employment to 45,000 people with a turnover of US\$9.6 billion. In regard to the current development and global economy, we will push our limits to US\$11.5 billion of turnover. Luckily, the turnover is expected to reach US\$32 billion in 2009.

### Prospect 2 Accelerate development of the biotechnology industry in STSP.

#### ■ Boost occupancy rate of standard factory for biotechnology in STSP.

The standard factory for biotechnology, totaling 24 units, with cGMP-approval in Tainan Science Park have been completed. Subsequent efforts will be placed on enterprises recruitment and elevate factories' occupancy rate.

#### ■ Establish the Medical Device Special Zone of the Kachslung Science Park.

35 acres in the south of Kaohsiung Science Park are reserved for the Medical Device Special Zone. By incorporating with the existing metal industry in southern Taiwan, the Administration will be able to highlight the industry clusters exclusively in the Kaohsiung Science Park, and hence develop into the largest research and development and manufacturing center for medical devices in the world.

## ■ Develop the Kaohsiung Biotechnology Park.

The Kaohsiung Biotechnology Park will be planned in detail according to the approved revision in 2005, and it will be completed and ready for tenants to move in by 2008.

#### Prospect 3 Develop the Administrative Service Zone into a small-scale world trade center.

The Administrative Service Zone covers 27 acres. The Administration Building, Police Building, and National Center for High-performance Computing have been inaugurated on January 30, 2005. Starting from 2007, the business hotel operated by the Ambassador Hotel, Convention and Exhibition Center (including the International Conference Hall), Financial Center, and Exhibition Hall will be completed, making STSP a small-scale world trade center.

## Prospect 4 Enhance talent training programs

The Administration continues to enhance the cultivation of manpower, and plans to start professional training programs and the "Program to Upgrade Industrial Technology and Enhance Human Resources" of NSC in 2005. Different kinds of training programs will be organized by the Association of Industries in Science Park in association with colleges and universities.

## Prospect 5 Promote the establishment of Nanke International School at Tainan Science Park.

The Administration will attempt to establish the Nanke International School in the Park, and the preparatory office along with preparation work such as land expropriation is scheduled to proceed in 2005. The school (including a bilingual department) will be established in 2006, and the construction of school buildings is to proceed. The high school department will be started in 2007 and completed in 2008.

# Prospect 6 Build the Sports Center, Health Club, and Community Center.


The Administration is second to none in making life at STSP more convenient. We have planned the Sports Center (with a softball field, basketball court, and tennis court), Health Club (featuring a badminton court, basketball court, table tennis court, a heated swimming pool, SPA facilities, fitness center, sauna and Jacuzzi, and Chinese and Western restaurants), and Community Center (including a children's day care center, stores, restaurants, a playground, and a multifunctional square) in the Park. They are scheduled to be completed in May 2005, June 2006, and April 2006, respectively.

## Prospect 7 Accelerate the development of the Kaohsiung Science Park.

In 2005, the Administration continues to nurture the telecommunications industry, to establish the Academia-Industry Consortium Promotion Committee, the Incubation and Innovation Center, and an access road to the Sun Yat-sen Expressway in order to develop the Kaohsiung Science Park.

# Prospect 8 Complete the High Speed Rail Vibration Reduction Program.

The on-site construction of the High Speed Rail Vibration Reduction Program is scheduled to be completed two months before the High Speed Rail is officially operated. The subsequent vibration reduction effect testing will be carried out in order to ensure vibration reduction quality.
